Bamaco, Inc. was low bidder on two projects of FEMA funded Ice Storm cleanup activity in McAlester, Oklahoma. These projects involved removing stockpile tree debris, trimming broken tree limbs from public right-of-way limits, and removal to our landfill for burning by City crews. The damage from the January, 2007 Ice Storm was extensive to the City resulting to date in approximately 190,000 cubic yards of tree and yard waste. Bamaco responded in removing the stockpiled debris in a very fast manner, exceeding our expectations. The tree trimming project is currently proceeding in a satisfactory manner at this time.

Mr. Pete Gonzales, Project Manager for Bamaco, has responded in a timely manner to all concerns from our citizens, our debris monitors, FEMA, or myself. I specifically appreciate his and the other Bamaco personnel's efforts in responding to public traffic issues and any citizen yard complaints.
